We have reviewed your proposed course outline for Chiropractic Assistant training.

Your course # **04-DCO-014** is approved for the following checked topics:

- Chiropractic Principles
- Management of Common Diseases
- History Taking
- Record Keeping
- Professional Standards
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Physiotherapy
- Acupuncture

You will not need to have your course re-approved each year if you do not change your course content or instructors. But re-approval is required if you modify your curriculum or add instructors. Also, your course would need to be re-approved if the supervising doctor becomes certified in a specialty area. R4-7-1102(A) requires that C.A.s complete 12 hours in that specialty, even if they are already registered.
