Completion of the Certified Chiropractic Sports Physician® program leads to Certificate Eligibility, a status which allows participants to take the written examination administered by the American Chiropractic Board of Sports Physicians™ (ACBSP™). This hybrid course includes live lectures that focus on hands on activities and distance based course work to allow you to maximize your learning investment and save you time. Program Schedule

Session I - March 10-11, 2012

Introduction to Sports Chiropractic and the Spine in Sport – *Dr. William Moreau*

Introduction includes information on becoming a team physician, managing concussion and spinal injury in sport. Learn about the current best practices regarding spondylolysis, cervical cord neuropraxia, brachial plexus injuries and much more. Presentation includes, actual athletic case studies treated by doctors of chiropractic. Session 2 - April 14-15, 2012
